



The IRA Charitable Rollover, passed by Congress, allows donors to distribute some (or all) of your required minimum distribution (RMD) to Biola as a qualified charity. The amount donated will not be subject to income tax for that year.

To make a gift using your RMD, please contact the custodian of your IRA and give the following instructions in order to take advantage of this provision:

1. Instruct your custodian as to the dollar amount of your RMD that you desire to be donated directly to Biola this year.
2. This is in accordance with the IRA Charitable Rollover Legislation.
3. Request that your custodian mail the check payable to Biola University and send to:

Please request that the check includes a notation with your name on it. You will then receive an acknowledgment of this distribution from Biola, though this will not qualify for a charitable deduction. The amount distributed will not be reported as income to you this year.
